Ashley Richburg's Breakfast Casserole Recipe

Ingredients:

- 24 oz frozen hash browns (8 cups)
- 16 oz cubed ham
- 8 oz sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
- 12 large eggs
- 1 cup milk
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
- cooking spray

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350
2. Add the frozen potatoes, ham, and cheese to a large bowl. Toss to combine. Pour the mixture into a 9X13 baking dish that has been sprayed with cooking spray.
3. In a large bowl, whisk the eggs with the milk, salt and pepper.
4. Pour the egg mixture over the hash brown mixture. Pat everything down with the back of a wooden spoon
5. Bake for one hour. The center should be set and the edges should be golden brown.



Meet Boyd Goen, Cornerstone Audiology Patient of the Month

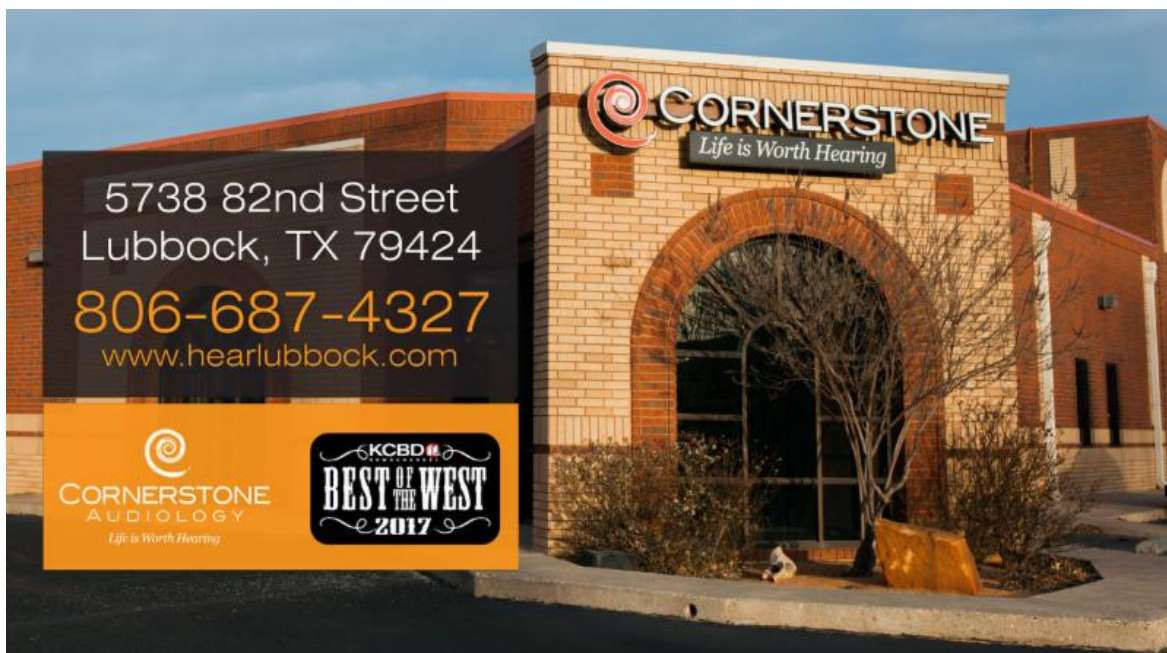
